**Remembrance  
Sunday**

With thanksgiving and sorrow I remembrance those who have died served this county in the Army, Navy and Air force. I remember those who served in the First and Second World wars and in conflicts and actions since.

I remember with great sorrow that around the world millions of military personnel and millions of civilians have died due to war and that war and conflicts continue.

I remember those who in bereavement, disability and pain, continue to suffer the consequences of fighting and terror.

I remember that each one of us can have opportunities, however small, to be peacemakers. I remember that one of my grandfathers, (a baker in civilian life, not in the army), served in the Royal Green Jackets in the First World War. He was captured and held as a prisoner of war in Germany. If he had not been, it is most likely he would have died in the fighting – and I would not have been born. In the Second World War he was not called up. There was an Italian prisoner of war camp near where he lived and he visited the prisoners, taking them cigarettes. When his friends and family asked him why his was visiting the enemy, he said because he knew what it was like to being held a prisoner in a foreign country.

I pray for peace; peace with justice, peace with mercy. I pray for the work of all peacemakers, peace seeker and peace keepers.
